Festivals: Saturday 13th March - Pasifika Festival – New Zealand

Pasifika Festival is one of the most significant cultural festivals in the Pacific region. Festival Day regularly attracts more than 200,000 people including over 1000 performers from Samoa, Tonga, Cook Islands, Fiji, Niue, Tahiti, Tokelau, Tuvalu, Kiribati and the Tangata Whenua (New Zealand Maori). There are debates, stories, dances and songs about this year's themes - the molokau (centipede) and the frangipani flower. The festival celebrates the unique cultures and identities of the Pacific nations and New Zealand. Each Pacific nation is unique in terms of their history, language, culture and traditions, and festival day gives a taste of each nation in its own "village", with traditional and contemporary performing arts, music and crafts. The villages also feature the best of Pacific cuisine, such as raw fish, pineapple pies and fresh coconuts.
